An additional area of focus will be determining how limited equity housing programs can impact future financial wealth-building and senior care options.

In addition to the housing work, MCDC is committed to providing high-quality services addressing various community issues. From succession planning to childcare solutions, access to essential services, and promoting value-added agriculture, MCDC remains dedicated to building local solutions for rural Montana's evolving needs. MCDC has experienced a 40% increase in demand for its services and has expanded programming to incorporate cooperative education and cooperative board development services, rural investment cooperatives, and Native American programming.

The partnership with national programs and organizations showcases MCDC's efforts to fulfill its mission and extend its positive impact on rural communities statewide. The work being done statewide underscores a collective effort to drive positive change, enhance living conditions, and fortify communities throughout Montana.
